- ❖ Induction programme is organised by the Company for the Directors joining the Board. Further, the Independent Directors are provided with the Policies, Code of Conducts adopted by the Company under the applicable regulations, terms of reference of the Board Committees etc.
- ❖ The Company, through its Executive Directors / Key Managerial Personnel / Senior Management Personnel, conduct programmes / presentations periodically in order to familiarize the Independent Directors with the Company's business model, nature, strategy, unit-wise operations, products, markets, finance, human resources, investor relations, litigations, internal code of conduct, policies and procedures and such other areas as may deem necessary from time to time;
- ❖ Presentation on internal controls on Financial and its Reporting, business operations, production, marketing, sales, finance and annual business plans which provides the Independent Directors an opportunity to understand the Company's strategic roadmap.
- ❖ Overall review of legal and regulatory updates and compliance.
- ❖ Site visits to the Company's plant locations which provides the Independent Directors an opportunity to understand the Company's business operations.
