

Kovilpatti Lakshmi Roller Flour Mills Limited

Details of Business

Since we began operations in 1963, Kovilpatti Lakshmi Roller Flour Mills Limited, has expanded to include Cast Iron Foundry in 2006 and Renewable Energy (KLRF Windmills 1995 & Solar Power Plant 2021). While at first glance these may appear to be divergent businesses, in fact, they have a common thread running through them all; a market need aligned to our business needs, and the creation of further opportunity for our community.

KLRF Foods - One of the pioneer wheat flour mills of South India, Kovilpatti Lakshmi Roller Flour Mills have been a symbol of consistent high quality since 1963. The company markets its various wheat products under the brand name viz., “KUTHUVILAKKU”, “KERA” and “ALAMARAM”. M/s Raya Foods Private Limited was amalgamated with us (appointed date 1-4-2022) effective from 1-2-2024.

Eltex Super Castings - Established in 1974 in the industrial hub of Coimbatore, Eltex Super Castings is a pioneering foundry in South India.

KLRF Windmills - The Wind power generation efforts began over 20 years ago, in 1995. Today, KLRF Windmills has a host of windmills located in Aralvaimozhi.

KLRF Solar Power Plant – Solar power plant with a capacity of 5 MW of was commissioned in December 2021 at Gangaikondan, in Tirunelveli district.

KLRF Foods

From a single mill producing 50 tonnes of flour in 1963, Kovilpatti Lakshmi Roller Flour Mills Ltd. has expanded both its product offerings and quantities of production significantly. Today, we mill over 5000 tonnes of food products every month, including Maida, Atta, Sooji and Bran.

KLRF Food Timeline

1961 - Incorporated on 16th December, as a private limited company with an authorised capital of 9 lakhs, installed capacity of 50 Tonnes

1982 - Converted into a public limited company on 8th May and capacity is increased to 2600 Tonnes per month

1989 - Capacity increased to 4700 Tonnes per month

2000 - Becomes the second ISO Certified Flour Mill in the country (ISO 9002:1994 by M/S TUV SUD). We introduce the new WWA (Whole Wheat Atta) production facilities. **2009** - Management system certification is changed to ISO 22000:2005 (Food safety management system) being a food product industry emphasizing hygiene and food safety requirements

2015 - Coveted Certificate ISO 27001: 2013 (ISMS, awarded by TUV SUD South Asia Pvt. Ltd.)

2017 - Present capacity is 6,000 Tonnes per month including Whole Wheat Atta grinding

2024 – Raya Foods Private Limited, Pondicherry having grinding capacity of 8,000 Tonnes per month was amalgamated with KLRF with effect from 1-4-2022.

KLRF Engineering

KLRF diversified into metal working, with the acquisition of a state-of-the-art foundry in the industrial city of Coimbatore. From an initial capacity of 1,500 MT in 1973, today Eltex Super Castings has a capacity to produce over 15,000 MT of precision-engineered parts.

KLRF Engineering Timeline

1973 -Incorporated with installed capacity of 1,500 Tonnes per annum.

1975 -Started commercial production. **1978** -Actual production crossed 1,200 Tonnes per annum.

1980 - Capacity increased to 3,600 Tonnes per annum **1983** - Increase in capacity to 4,800 Tonnes per annum.

2006 - Amalgamation with KLRF group.

2013 - Capacity increased to 10,800 Tonnes per annum.

2019 - Capacity increased to 15,000 Tonnes per annum.
